

Our Lost Canyon Adventure is an experience of a lifetime – go where very few have had the privilege to roam! Imagine yourself in the midst of thick rainforest at the top of a magical canyon full of tropical waterfalls with surprises each step of the way.

**Travel the old-fashioned way!** You've probably heard about Costa Rica's famous bumpy backroads – start off by doing a fun 4x4 off-road adventure on our "Jungle Limos" as you head about 15 minutes into a quiet mountainside community.

Bring on the adrenaline!!! Experienced and first-time rafters love the Río Toro for full-day, class 3-4 rafting. The Río Toro offers more continuous rapids along its 16 kilometers of deep-canyon gorges than any other river in Costa Rica. You'll see waterfalls and abundant wildlife such as sloths, monkeys and tropical birds, including toucans and the Montezuma Oropendula. Imagine rafting through exciting, action-packed rapids with names like "Morning Coffee," "the Danish Taco," "Coco Loco," "the Eraser," and the famous "B-F-R!"

#### This is a thrilling, once-in-a-lifetime adventure!



What to expect... Take a nice, scenic drive to our private put in at the Toro river bridge and then our experienced guides will give you a thorough safety talk, get you set up with your helmet, life jacket and paddle and then you're off – you'll be paddling for more than  $2\frac{1}{2}$  hours down one of Costa Rica's mostamazing rivers!

We'll stop along the way for a nice, tropical fruit break and afterwards, we take you to our private river house for a typical Costa Rican, natural, all-you can-eat lunch. You'll return to La Fortuna and the Arenal Area around 3:30-4:00pm. The Río Toro is located only one hour from La Fortuna – it's closer than the Sarapiqui and Pacuare Rivers & the perfect rafting trip if traveling from San José to La Fortuna.

**Please note:** If river conditions are unsuitable for the Río Toro, our head guide might make the call to change to a back-up river of similar or equal level and/or offer another tour, such as our half-day whitewater raft tour on the Río Balsa. We are lucky that our river levels are controlled by the water release of electrical dams so we have excellent water all-year-long. However, sometimes there is less-electricity production on Sundays in Costa Rica, so in dry season we may have to make a change of rivers or activities. Our plan is to always have a fun, but <u>safe</u> day!

If river conditions are unsuitable for the Río Sarapiquí, our head guide might make the call to change to a back-up river of a similar level and/or offer another tour. We depend on Mother Nature for good water flow, but water levels may be low in dry season. Part of the Sarapiquí River is also controlled by a hydroelectric dam which may result in slightly lowerwater levels on the weekends. Our back-up river options include the lower section of the Río Sarapiquí Class 2-3 at La Virgen, Río Toro class 3-4, Río Balsa class 2-3 or Río Tenorio Class 3-4 – you're always guaranteed a fun, but safe day! You get a full refund if no tour is run.



# Mountain Bike Local Tour (Volcano Ride)



We'll take a moderate-level guided ride near the base of Volcano Arenal and along Lake Arenal. Get excellent views of volcano and surrounding jungle and farmlands.

<u>Tour logistics</u>: We pick you up at your hotel and head out to the starting point on an old road connecting Arenal Dam with the main entrance to Arenal Volcano National Park. Your guide will get you set up with your suspension bike, helmet and gloves, go over the safety talk and then we take off on a very scenic, easy-going ride.

You'll be traveling a distance of about 12 to 26 kms (8 to 16 miles) and gain about 85 mts (280 ft) on secondary gravel roads.

This ride takes us from the small Costa Rican town of El Castillo. Along the ride we're always on the lookout for howler monkeys, exotic, tropical birds like toucans, oropendulas and kingfishers.

We'll stop for a snack along the banks of Lake Arenal

# **Volunteering at Proyecto Asís**





This hands-on one-day volunteer project puts you in direct contact with local fauna and flora in a very down-to-earth environment. This project is part of our "People-Planet-Profit" triple-bottomline philosophy.



We start with an easy 30-minute orientation walk through secondary rainforest that surrounds the wild animal rescue shelter to get to know the story behind this grassroots endeavor. Proyecto Asis was established about 12 years ago - Proyecto Asis founder Don Jaime del Castillo and his son Alvaro had a dream to turn the once-abandoned farm back into vibrant rainforest while providing a sanctuary for hundreds of species of birds and other wildlife.

You will be put to work feeding a few of the animals such as wild boars, kinkajous, monkeys, caimans & more along the way, plus other helpful activities such as trail repair, cage building, painting, planting trees and more.

Throughout the morning, you'll get a good understanding of how Proyecto Asis works to rehabilitate injured and abandoned animals & release them back to their environment, as well as educational programs underway to help prevent hunting and poaching of the surrounding Children's Eternal Rainforest that connects with Monteverde. This unique tour includes transport and refreshment - proceeds donated to Proyecto Asis. Perfect for families!

The Desafío Community, Culture and Conservation tour is the perfect way to get to know the real Costa Rica and get direct contact with some of the promising projects happening in and around the area.



The visit includes a stop at the Bio-diesel project to see first-hand the process used to to learn about their work to produce a renewable evergy sourse for their vehicles.

We then visit the Proyecto Asis Animal Rescue Shelter where clients are treated to an easy 30-minute walk through secondary rainforest. Then help feed wild animals such as crocodiles, wild boars, and monkeys and learn about local efforts to rehabilitate injured, abandoned animals to release them back to their environment, as well as educational programs underway to help prevent hunting and poaching of the surrounding Children's Rainforest.

The next stop is the Luna Nueva organic farm to walk through a medicinal plant garden to learn about "miracle" natural cures like ginger, turmeric and other good-for-you things found right in our backyards. Clients then become gourmet organic cooks by choosing products straight from the farm and learning how to cook them up in a natural way.

# Rainforest Mysteries Tour at Luna Nueva





Visit the organic/biodynamic herbal estate called Luna Nueva for a great opportunity to learn about all aspects of the rainforest and how it relates to us as humans and what we eat. A wonderful, relaxing, informative day tour with organic lunch and bilingual guide.



We start with a welcome refreshment and fresh fruit and introductions. We then head out on an all-access Interpretive Rainforest hike. You'll get a chance to taste the local harvests of fresh vegetables and herbs and learn about medicinal plants and sustainable agriculture. We finish up with lunch a visit to the Finca Luna Nueva gift shop and Arenal volcano viewing.

# Liquid Lava Volcano Walk - early morning or twilight hike (El Silencio Reserve)




This is the quintessential tour to do when you're in La Fortuna near the Arenal Volcano. You'll walk with a naturalist guide through the El Silencio nature reserve that skirts the bottom section of the volcano. You'll be surrounded by lush rainforest and vibrant wildlife.

When the volcano is in its active phase and emitting red, molten rock, once we finish the walk, we'll head to the active side to see

where we may spot red lava falling from the volcano. You can partake in sharing some Liquid Lava (a mix of local "fire water" and natural drink.) As we say: "If you can't see the lava, at least you'll be able to feel it..."

For those who wish to finish off the night relaxing in natural hot springs, you can try Baldí hot springs with over 22 different temperature pools, swim-up bars, locker rooms, restaurant and a young, lively atmosphere. We also recommend you chose hotels that have their own hot springs on site.

## Mountain Biking from Arenal Volcano to Monteverde

People who love to ride mountain bikes can now do so as a means of transport up to Monteverde – do an adventure on the way to your next destination, as a part of the innovative Desafío Adventure Connection.

This intense ride is about 3-hours long or about 25 miles. We'll start at the Lake Arenal Dam where you drop off your luggage with Captain Marquez, our boat driver. From there, we ride past the rural community of El Castillo until we get to the pristine Caño Negro river that runs alongside Rancho Margot. From here we do a technical river crossing and continue riding through rolling hills along the edge of picture-perfect Lake Arenal until ride to the small town of Río Chiquito.

Upon arrival to Río Chiquito, you will be reunited with your luggage and drive the remaining 1.5-hours up the steep, gravel roads to your hotel in Monteverde. We also have an office up in Monteverde should you need any help in the area.

This is a truly adventurous ride – the terrain is rugged, the scenery is incredible but this is the perfect way to travel between La Fortuna and Monteverde.

**Departure**: 8:30am (departure depends on hotel location)

#### Horseback to the La Fortuna Waterfall

#### **Arenal Volcano National Park Hike**

We'll along the trails of the Arenal National Park. Along the way we'll enter the tropical rainforest and areas which were once devastated by the fury of the volcano explosion of 1968. During the hike, it is possible to see a great variety of flora and fauna characteristic of the area while you walk through the lava fields of 1992.



While in the park it is possible to listen to the constant activity of the volcano with its lava flows and sporadic eruptions, and on clear days you will have a magnificent view of the impressive Arenal Volcano, the Arenal Lagoon and the extinct volcano Cerro Chato. By night time, the lava flows are visible down the side of the volcano in streaks of red, hot molten lava

Your naturalist guide will provide important and interesting information about the main characteristics of the volcano, active since 1968, & many more important details of everything you will encounter alongside the trail. As an added attraction you can purchase an entrance to the different hot spring. We will drop you there after the tour, so you can relax and we'll pick you up a couple of hours later to take you back to your hotel.

**Departure time in the morning:** 8:00am approx Return: 12:00pm and 3:00pm approx. #### Sunset Cruise on Lake Arenal
